


**ROYAL BOROUGH OF WINDSOR & MAIDENHEAD**  
**REMEMBRANCE SERVICES & PARADES 2024**  
**SECTION 21 OF THE TOWN POLICE CLAUSES ACT 1847**  
**FOR THE PREVENTION OF OBSTRUCTION**

WHEREAS during certain hours on Sunday 10<sup>th</sup> November 2024 the roads referred to in the attached Schedule, will be thronged and liable to be obstructed. The Royal Borough of Windsor & Maidenhead, pursuant to the powers conferred by Section 21 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847, does HEREBY ORDER AND DIRECT that for the purposes of preventing obstruction in the roads on the said days, the following regulations shall be observed on those dates and between the hours specified in Column 3 of the Schedule attached hereto.

1. The lengths of roads specified in the Schedule, hereto shall be closed to all vehicles except those listed in Article 2. listed below.
2. The roads shall remain open to:-
  - (a) Vehicles belonging to the Fire, Ambulance and Police Services
  - (b) Pedestrians
  - (c) Bicycles and invalid carriages
  - (d) Vehicles permitted onto the road by a Police Officer in uniform or with the written permission of the Borough's Traffic Manager
3. The persons specified in Column 4 of the Schedule shall be responsible for the provision of signposting in compliance with the instructions of the Borough's Traffic Manager

The Penalty for infringement of the said Regulations is a fine not exceeding £1,000
