Cllr E. Larcombe – Wall for the property at the top of Coppermill Road Sunnyside has a big piece missing, Cllr E. Larcombe asked if there had been a planning application appeal, Clerk confirmed initial planning application in 2022 was refused 22/02089/FULL and appeal dismissed. Planning application in 2024 24/00289/FULL was refused, appeal is unknown.

PSPC (Public Space Protection Order) coming through from April on catapults.

Cllr B. Hickley is in talks with Wise about how we can tackle fly tipping within Horton and to improve the current report, due to key known hotspots being missing.

Clerk report included updates on Fly tipping cases reported to the borough. And discussion with the RBWM Warden to tackle the issue at Poyle Poplar Car Park.

The road by Kingsmead has been causing problems with significant Debruy in the road even after a road sweep has been through – Clerk to speak with Cappagh to see if we can work on a solution.

Information on road closures and no fly zone initiated due to state visit issued by RBWM.
